AFFILIATE COMMITTEE - The Affiliate Committee is a group of dedicated affiliate members of the Loveland-Berthoud Association of REALTORS®. Affiliate members are comprised individuals that are not engaged in the real estate profession but have interests requiring information concerning real estate.

The committee helps strengthen the REALTOR® Association through volunteer opportunities, sponsorship of events, and educational programs. This Committee also serves as a great platform for affiliate networking.

CARHOF - Colorado Association of REALTORS® Housing Opportunity Foundation. CARHOF is a 501(c) 3 charitable foundation created for the purpose of promoting safe, decent, and affordable housing. The purpose of this committee is to educate the members on the benefits of the CARHOF foundation, to solicit Real Estate Offices, lending institutions and Title Company's participation. To review applications received from local non-profit organizations for foundation grants and to make recommendations to the board of directors as to which organizations should receive the grant money.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS - The purpose of the committee is to maintain a good REALTOR® image in the community and to aid and guide the membership of the Association in sponsoring projects that will improve the community. These projects should be chosen to demonstrate the REALTORS® concern for, and interest in our community.

EDUCATION - The duties of this Committee are to have at least two representatives from the committee attend the annual meeting of the Tri City Education Foundation (Loveland, Fort Collins & Greeley) to determine which classes will be sponsored by the Tri City Education Foundation and the dates those classes will be held. This committee will also make recommendations for educational classes and seminars held by the Loveland-Berthoud Association.

GOLF TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE – the committee will determine date, time, place & cost of the Annual Golf Tournament. The tournament is a fundraiser for two scholarships that are given annually each for \$500.00, the Don Evans Awards that are given to Middle School Students for achieving a 4.0 throughout middle school and any remaining funds will go to the CARHOF (*Colorado Association of REALTORS® Housing Opportunity Foundation*).

GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS - This Committee will interview candidates running for local public office, and statewide public office in conjunction with CAR. The Committee will make recommendations to the Board of Directors for campaign contributions for candidates, support of Ballot Issues and Non-Ballot Issues. The committee will help to keep the membership informed on important issues. The committee will work with the PSF Fundraising Chairperson to help educate members on what PSF and RSDC are, and the importance of their contributions.

GRIEVANCE - The Grievance Committee shall consist of active REALTOR® members of the Association, appointed by the President, subject to confirmation by the Board of Directors. All Grievance committee members of the Loveland-Berthoud Association of REALTORS® shall be required to attend training every two (2) years. The Grievance Committee will review Ethics and Arbitration Complaints submitted to the Association. This committee will meet only as needed.

INSTALLATION COMMITTEE – This committee will work with the President-elect to plan the Installation Banquet. Invitations, menu, color scheme, table decorations, etc.

PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS - The Professional Standards Committee shall consist of active REALTOR® members of the Association, appointed by the President, subject to confirmation by the Board of Directors. All Professional Standards committee members of the Loveland-Berthoud Association of REALTORS® shall be required to attend training every two (2) years. This committee shall be directed by the bylaws of the Loveland-Berthoud Association of REALTORS®. This committee will meet as needed.

PROGRAM- The committee will plan programs for the Monthly Membership meetings that are held on the second Thursday of each month. The committee will plan a program, find a sponsor for each meeting and help to promote the meetings to the members. Committee members should also make an attempt to attend the membership meetings.

TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE - This committee will keep abreast of technological changes in the industry. The committee will advise the Board of Directors on issues that affect the Real Estate Industry, plan programs and events that will educate the members.
